



**2021 Tillotson T4 World Cup**

**Whiteriver Park, Collon, Co. Louth**

**18-19 September 2021**

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

**1. Event:** Motorsport Ireland are running the Tillotson T4 World Cup at the above venue on 18-19 September 2021.

**2.** The circuit is 1200 metres in length, up to 12 metres in width and the surface is tarmacadam.

**3.** The event will be run under the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), Appendix 70.1, 70.2 & 70.3 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook, these Supplementary Regulations current HSE/government regulations and guidelines regarding Covid-19 and any other Instructions published by MI relating to the event. **4. Clerk of the Course:** Vincent Hayes

**Motorsport Ireland Stewards:**

**5. Judges of Fact:** Judges will be named in the supplementary regulations or final instructions. A nominated Starting Judge, or Judges to observe the start and declare any false starts or other infringements. The Starter shall be a judge of fact and shall be an appointed start judge. A Finish Judge to declare the order in which the karts cross the finish line when the end of the race is given. A Chief Timekeeper to declare the individual lap times and the order in which the karts cross the timing line throughout the competition. A Weighing Scales Judge to confirm the actual weight of competing karts and report any breach of the minimum weights to the Clerk of The Course. This function may also be performed by a licenced scrutineer. Minimum weight limits will be strictly enforced.

**6.** Observers and/or Assistant Judges of Fact may be appointed and they will report as appropriate to the Clerk of The Course.

**7. Entrants** - This event, while running under a national permit, allows for international participation under Art 2.3.8c of the FIA International Sporting Code. All entrants must hold one of the following:

1. Kart race licence from MI or MSUK.

2 International kart race licence from an FIA ASN with an endorsement thereon granting the licence holder permission to enter foreign events. If no endorsement is on the licence, a letter from your ASN is required.

3 Kart race National B or National A licence from your FIA ASN together with a letter from your ASN granting you permission to start at this event.

Please note that these are the only 3 available methods to enter the event. It is your responsibility to obtain the necessary paperwork from your ASN. No exceptions can be made as these are rules laid down by the FIA.

Competitors and service crew from outside the island of Ireland should check latest travel advice and must be aware that changes in travel regulations may result in them not being able to travel to compete in the event. This event is restricted to the driver plus one service crew member. In the case

of drivers under 18 years of age, where a parent is neither the entrant or a service crew member, one parent is also permitted to attend.

**8.** Drivers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a licensed competitor entrant. This competitor entrant must also submit a COVID-19 self-declaration form.

**9. Photographers** - Only Garda vetted Motorsport Ireland licenced photographers are allowed on race track and they must wear their current MI Media Bib. Photographers wishing to attend must inform the event secretary and submit a COVID-19 self-declaration form.

**10. Tyres** - Tyres will be bar code scanned at pre-race scrutiny and must be used for official practice, heats and finals. Tyres allowed is only 1 set of slicks for race Event. Tyres are Maxxis T4 Slick and Maxxis T4 Wet. Tyres must be presented to scrutiny for scanning prior to official practice on Saturday. Damaged tyres may be replaced with an equally worn replacement at the discretion of the scrutineer.

**11. Fuel.** APPLEGREEN STATION COLON.

**12. Cameras** - Cameras on helmets are not allowed. Competitors may not use camera on their karts  
Tillotson can request for a driver to use a camera for event streaming and capturing media content. Where an on-board camera or other recording device is fitted to a kart both the fitting and the device must be examined by a Scrutineer to ensure that it is safe before the competitor takes part in practice or race.

**13.** The duties given to the Clerk of the Course may be delegated to one or more assistants. The names and the functions of these assistants will be given in final instructions. The Clerk of the Course may specifically delegate his disciplinary duties and the hearing of protests to an assistant whose name and function shall be published in the Final Instructions.

**14.** The penalty for breach of the technical regulations shall normally be exclusion from the session where the infringement was detected (timed practice, qualifying, heat, super heat, final), unless otherwise stated for a specific offence.

**15. Opening Spots on Grid:** Where a competitor fails to present themselves to the assembly grid for a race, all other competitors shall move up a place to close the grid spot.

**16. Covid Compliance Judge of Fact:** The official named in the final instructions as COVID-19 Compliance Officer shall be a judge of fact.

**17. Signing of Results:** Results shall be published on the [www.timing.ie](http://www.timing.ie) website. There shall be no official notice board as per the MI return to sport document.

**18. Covid 19 Regulations:**

18.1. A covid compliance officer will be present at the event to ensure all competitors and mechanics are complying with the protocols. This officer will be deemed a judge of fact.

18.2. Any competitor/ mechanic / team principle / entrant who fails to comply with the COVID-19 regulations, guidelines and protocols as published by [www.gov.ie](http://www.gov.ie) and the HSE as determined by the Covid-19 compliance officer shall be reported to the stewards for a dangerous act. This decision will inevitably lead to disqualification from the competition. This decision becomes immediately binding and is not subject to protest or appeal.

**ALL COMPETITORS AND TEAMS HAVE TO REPORT TO COVID OFFICER AT ENTRANCE GATE ON SATURDAY & SUNDAY MORNING BY 9AM TO BE CHECKED AND ISSUED WITH WRISTBAND.**

NO PERSON WILL BE ADDED TO THE ATTENDANCE LIST AFTER CUT OFF POINT ON **THURSDAY** PRIOR TO EVENT. THE LIST WILL BE FINAL AT THAT POINT AND NO ADDITIONS CAN BE MADE. IF YOU HAVE NOT COMPLETED YOUR PAPERWORK AND SUBMITTED IT YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN.

PARKING: A PARKING PLAN HAS BEEN DRAWN UP FOR WHITERIVER AND EVERYBODY MUST ADHERE/COMPLY WITH THE PLAN. NON COMPLIANCE WITH PARKING INSTRUCTIONS WILL INCUR A PENALTY.

PRIZEGIVING : NOTE ALL THOSE RECEIVING PRIZES OVER 12 MUST WEAR A FACE MASK.

18.3. Only those people listed will be admitted on the day anybody not listed will be refused admission.

**18.4. Each person entering will be temperature tested on arrival.**

18.5. Vehicles will be checked upon entry to ensure only the registered persons are present.

18.6. Drivers will have to wear face protection when approaching the grid area and in parc ferme post race.

18.7. No competitor or official may enter the timing hut.

18.8. Any person who knowingly makes a false statement on the Covid declaration form will be considered to be in breach of GCR 139 6.1.3 a dangerous act. The penalty for violation is disqualification. The decision becomes immediately binding and is not subject to protest or appeal.
